ENTRIES: Entries will close promptly at game time. Players arriving late will only be allowed to play at the discretion of the Head Tournament Director.

SEEDING: Seeding will be done at the discretion of the Tournament Chairman and the Seeding Committee. Every effort will be made to balance the field. Pairs expecting to be seeded must purchase their entries at least 15 minutes before game time. Late arrivals will not be seeded.

TIMED EVENT: Players who continue to take more than their allotted time will be warned and penalized. Directors have been instructed to enforce slow play penalties. Repeated slowness may result in disciplinary action.

BIDDING BOXES: Bidding boxes will be used at all tables unless there are physical problems which hinder their use. If a card is missing from your box or damaged, please notify the director.

REGISTRATION & INFORMATION: Located in the Foyer of the playing level. Please register in person and only once during the tournament to receive your registration gift. 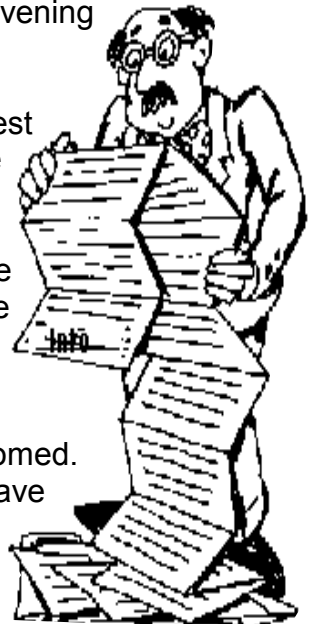

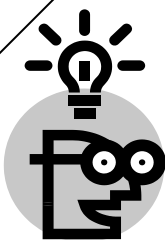
